HOW TO GET TO PERUGIA by car

Perugia

Perugia is a historic city in central Italy, known for its rich cultural heritage, medieval architecture, and vibrant atmosphere. As the capital of the Umbria region, it sits atop a hill with stunning views of the surrounding countryside. Perugia is famous for its well-preserved medieval old town, including the Palazzo dei Priori, the Cathedral of San Lorenzo, and the Fontana Maggiore.

The city is home to one of Italy's oldest universities, the University of Perugia, which gives it a youthful, international vibe. Perugia is also renowned for its annual Umbria Jazz Festival and the Eurochocolate festival, celebrating its long-standing tradition in chocolate-making. Its charming streets, artistic treasures, and cultural events make it a popular destination for visitors seeking a blend of history and modernity.

From Perugia "San Francesco d'Assisi" Airport

The closest airport is the modest Umbria International Airport (PEG). The airport is located at approximately 17 km from the conference venue, which can be reached with an estimated travel time of 20 - 30 minutes.

From Rome "Leonardo da Vinci" Airport

The main international italian airport –Leonardo da Vinci – Fiumicino airport (FCO) is located at approximately 200 km from the conference venue, with an estimated travel time to reach the conference venue of 2-3 hours.

From Florence "Amerigo Vespucci" Airport

Coming from the north: Motorway A14 Adriatica > exit Cesena (160 km from Perugia) towards Rome-Perugia (E45SS3BIS) until the exit Perugia "Prepo".

Highway A1 del Sole > exit Valdichiana towards Perugia (E45-SS3BIS) until the exit Perugia "Prepo".

Coming from the south: Highway A14 Adriatica > exit Civitanova Marche towards Foligno-Assisi-Perugia (E45 -SS3BIS) until the exit Perugia "Prepo".

HOW TO GET TO PERUGIA by public transports

From Perugia "San Francesco d'Assisi" Airport

UMBRIA AIRLINK Buses - Umbria Airlink is the service, in collaboration with Trenitalia, that connects the cities of Perugia and Assisi to the international airport of Umbria "San Francesco d'Assisi". The route includes a reduced number of stops to allow the ascent and descent from the airport to the cities of Perugia and Assisi. The stops are easily visible, thanks to the specific graphics of Umbria Airlink. Tickets can be purchased at the airport bar. The routes coincide with the arrivals and departures of flights.
